



All chametz must be disposed of before Passover and should not remain in your possession during Passover. All chametz that you cannot dispose of may be sold by giving Rabbi Lehrfield power of attorney to draw up the Legal Deed of Sale. Rabbi Lehrfield will be available in the Shul for the sale of your Chametz after services or by appointment. It is preferable to do this in person so that you can make a kinyan (official) transaction with the Rabbi. If you cannot do this in person, please complete, sign, and mail or fax the form below to Rabbi Lehrfield's attention. Please make sure the Rabbi is in possession of this form no later than 9:00 am on Erev Pesach April 22nd.
